Jorge Mario Velásquez Jaramillo was born on June 7, 1960, in Bogotá, Colombia. Before playing his role as president of Grupo Argos, he developed an outstanding career as president of Cementos Argos, a leading company in the Cement business in Colombia, with presence in 15 countries and currently the second largest concrete producer in the United States.

This business leader, who began his career at Argos in 1986 as a practitioner, held various positions at Cementos Argos in the past, including the Vice President of Logistics of Argos, the General Management of Cementos del Nare, the Presidency of Cementos Paz del Río and the Caribbean Regional Vice Presidency, with responsibilities for Cementos Argos operations in Panama, Haiti, Dominican Republic, Suriname and island territories, as well as the company's international trade.

He is currently a senior member of the board of directors of Cementos Argos, Celsia, Odinsa, Fundación Grupo Argos, the National Association of Entrepreneurs - ANDI, Proantioquia, and the Superior Council of the EIA University.
