Grupo Argos, a holding company with sustainable investments in infrastructure, closed the acquisition of 30% of the shares of Opain S.A., a concession company in charge of the management, operation, commercial exploitation, maintenance, modernization and expansion of passenger and cargo terminals at El Dorado International Airport Bogota. This transaction was closed according to the provisions of the asset purchase agreement signed in November 2016, following the fulfillment of all the conditions precedent and obtaining of the corresponding authorizations.

With this acquisition, Grupo Argos now controls Opain, considering that Odinsa S.A., a road and airport concession subsidiary, has a 35% stake in Opain.

El Dorado International Airport is the third largest airport in Latin America in number of passengers, after the airports of Mexico City and Sao Paulo, transporting more than 30 million people a year. Additionally, it is the first airport in cargo transport, with a volume of 670 thousand tons per year. The concession of the passenger and cargo terminals has an area of over 200,000 square meters.
